## *Roska's Kick-Around Service*

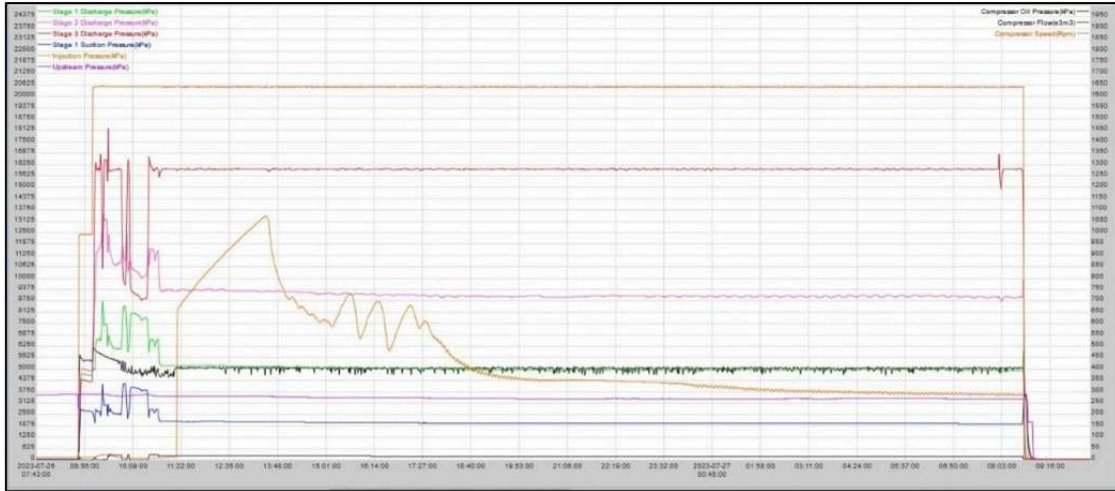
**Kickaround** is an alternative to blowdowns, swabbing, or high-pressure nitrogen and is suitable for wells with high reservoir pressure.

The benefits are fluids are produced down the pipeline in a closed system, with no venting or flaring, and clients use their own gas.



The chart below is a snapshot showing Roska DBO's Kickaround service unloading a client's liquid-loaded gas well. Take note of the orange chart line showing gas pressure in the casing. You see the pressure build on the backside

of the casing, the well unloads, then builds and unloads a few more times as the tubing is cleaned out. The next day, we rigged out with the well flowing independently and production restored.
